1. Cautions Concerning Installation

For details about supported operating systems, refer to "System Requirements" in the Operator's Guide or Basic Operation Guide of your ScanSnap model.

When installing ScanSnap Online Update on Mac OS, first log in as a user with administrator privileges, and then install ScanSnap Online Update.

The following message box may appear after the installation,

"AOUMonitor wants to make changes. Type an administrator's name and password to allow this."

In that case, enter a user name with administrator privileges and a password, and then click [OK].

* When you click [Cancel], follow the procedure below.

- i) Log in as a user with administrator privileges.
- ii) From the sidebar in Finder, select [Applications] → [ScanSnap Online Update] and then double-click [AOU Settings] to open the [ScanSnap Online Update Settings] window.

- iii) Select the [Enable automatic online update] checkbox. (If it is already selected, clear it first to close the window, and start again from step ii above.)

2. Cautions Concerning Uninstallation

Uninstall all ScanSnap related software before uninstalling ScanSnap Online Update.

Quit the ScanSnap Online Update application before uninstalling it.

3. Change from the previous version

Changes from V2.0L20 to V2.0L40

The main change is as follows.

- A new option has been added to notify information about ScanSnap.
- The start time for automatic online update has been changed from "on the hour (0 minutes)" to the one-hour period (between 0 and 59 minutes) following the hour you specify.

Changes from V2.0L14 to V2.0L20

The main change is as follows.

- The ScanSnap Improvement Program (*) has been added.
 - *: The program helps to improve ScanSnap by collecting anonymous data from ScanSnap.
 - The collected data do not contain any personal data.

Changes from V2.0L13 to V2.0L14

The main change is as follows.

- A modification has been made so the new software that has not been installed is notified by the automatic online update only when it becomes available.

Changes from V2.0L12 to V2.0L13

The main change is as follows.

- A modification has been made so you can specify in the settings window to skip the checking for available updates of your desired software.

Changes from V2.0L11 to V2.0L12

The main change is as follows.

- Fixed the error where an unexpected error occurs or the download window remains open if network error occurs during downloading of multiple software.
- Fixed the error where the error message is not displayed even when the download failed on installation from the displayed list of updates in the latter half of the update.
- Fixed the error where excessive help cache is cleared during installation.

Changes from V2.0L10 to V2.0L11

The main change is as follows.

- Fixed the error where installation continues while downloading updates from the list of updates is not yet completed successfully and may end in failure.

Changes from V1.0L50 to V2.0L10

The main change is as follows.

- A new feature has been added to check ScanSnap-related software available online, and install them newly.
- Modified the error where the error message "An internal error occurred" appears when you deny the confirmation message appearing under an administrator account while running ScanSnap Online Update.

Changes from V1.0L40 to V1.0L50

The main change is as follows.

- A modification has been made so that the summary of updates appears immediately after the updates list is displayed.

Changes from V1.0L20 to V1.0L40

The main change is as follows.

- Minor errors have been modified.

Changes from V1.0L11 to V1.0L20

The main change is as follows.

- Modified the error where ScanSnap Online Update may not be registered as a login item.
- Modified the error where installation may be rejected by the permissions checker on the destination.

Changes from V1.0L10 to V1.0L11

The main change is as follows.

- Modified the error where update notification may fail.
